Will Canada impose a surtax on Chinese-made electric vehicles?

The Canadian government has launched a 30-day consultation to determine whether to impose a surtax on solar products, semiconductors, batteries, and battery parts from China. It recently slapped a 100% surtax on Chinese-made electric vehicles.

Does Canada have a solar industry?

But two years ago, Canada had fallen to the 20th in the world. Canada's solar manufacturing industry also has little presence. As Q2 2024, North American module production capacity is about 42.32GW, mainly concentrated in the United States and Mexico, with Canada's module production capacity being only 1.13GW.
