Note: Singapore has mandated the installation of residual current circuit breakers (RCCBs) in all Housing Board (HDB) flats and private dwellings by July 1, 2025. Non-compliance may result in a fine of \$5,000.

A RCCB (Residual Current Circuit Breaker) is a type of circuit breaker that cuts off the electricity supply immediately upon detecting leakages that may result in an electric shock.
