How much does a shipping container cost in Australia?

Prices depend heavily on size, condition (new vs used), type, and availability. Delivery often ranges from \$330 to \$1,600+ depending on distance and access. You'll also want to budget for site prep, permits, unloading/crane costs, and customisations (insulation, doors, windows etc.). How much does it cost to buy a shipping container in Australia?

Why are shipping containers so expensive?

Shipping container prices can vary depending on several key factors: Size & Type - 40ft and High Cubes cost more than standard 20ft units. Condition - New (one-trip) containers are more expensive than used or refurbished. Delivery Location - Remote or regional delivery may incur higher transport costs.

How much does a 20 ft container cost?

A 20ft container in pristine condition may be priced between \$3,000 and \$5,000, while a 40ft container could range from \$5,500 to \$8,000. Pre-owned containers offer a considerable cost advantage, with prices ranging from \$1,500 for a standard 10ft model to approximately \$3,500 for a larger or better-condition 40ft container.

How much does a 40ft container cost?

A 40ft standard container from China to the US West Coast costs \$3,500-\$6,000. Shipping to the East Coast ranges from \$4,500-\$7,500. These rates include base ocean freight and surcharges but not destination charges, customs clearance, or inland transportation. High-demand periods can push rates 30%-50% higher.
